## 2018 Milestones

- **371 Individuals** impacted by HIV/AIDS served.
- **2,560 Hours** of Mental Health Services.
- **8,736 Hours** of Medical Case Management.
- **\$41,947.00** paid in childcare assistance.
- **34,560 Miles** approximately driven by case managers to provide services.
- **2 Residential youth leadership camps/conferences** provided to youth ages 7-26 impacted by HIV/AIDS. (250 family members served)
- **7,260 Volunteer hours** logged by over 45 volunteers.
- **5 Community Lunch and Learns** held on educational topics open to HIV community and providers in Sacramento region.
- **113 medications per month** on average delivered to clients.
- **52 families (107 children)** received family necessities and gifts from their wish lists during the holiday season, in collaboration with Sacramento State University.
- **2 healthy HIV negative babies born** as a result of intensive support to 2 HIV positive mothers.
- **87 school age kids provided with backpacks** and school supplies, in collaboration with The Backpack Project.
- **336 food bags** given out to clients in need, in collaboration with Strategies for Change.
- **50 HIV positive women** provided with ongoing support groups.
- **12 Teen support group sessions** held for HIV positive teens.
- **6 Pre-Teen Educational Support Group Sessions** held for HIV positive pre-teens.

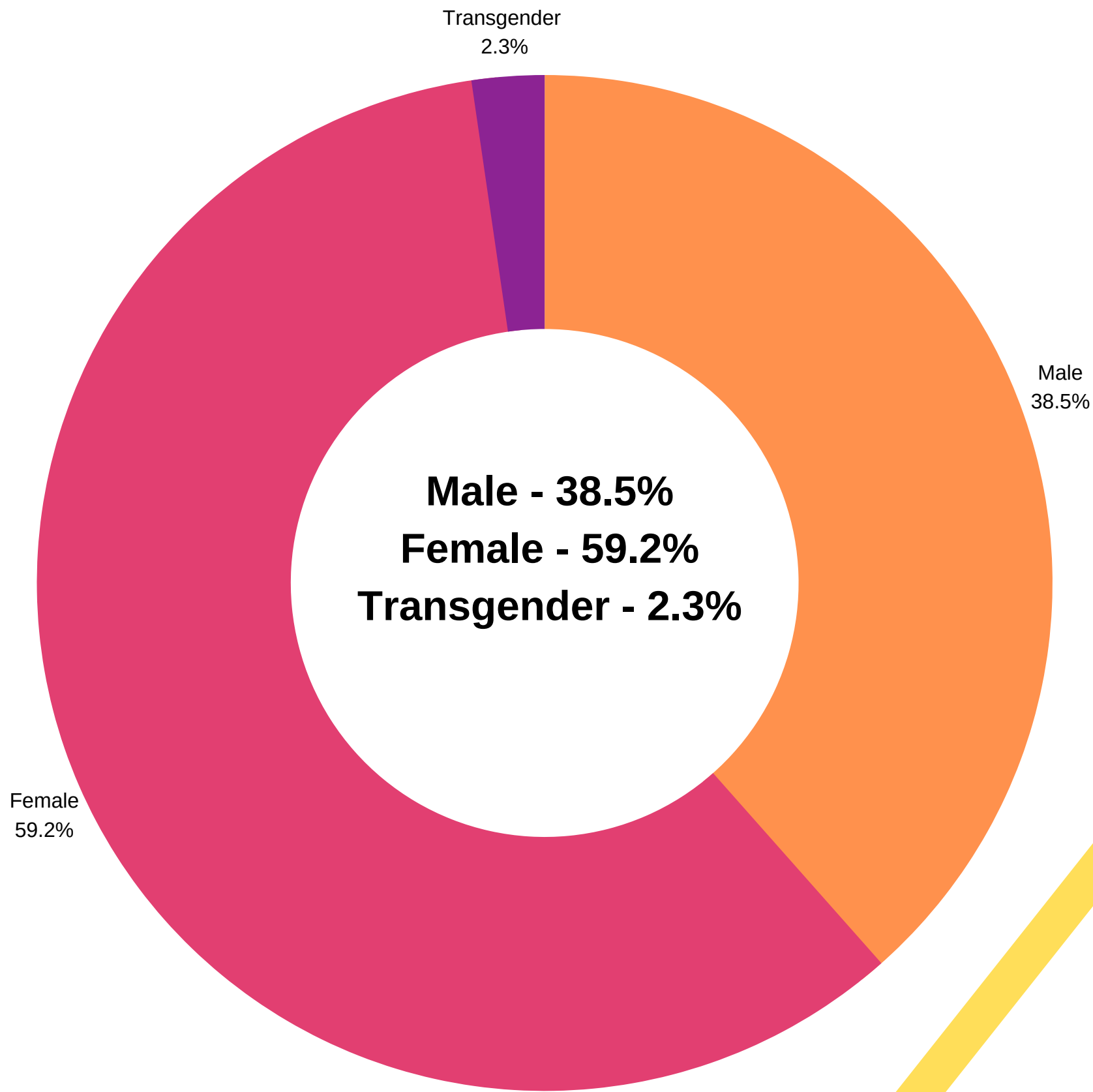
## Mission

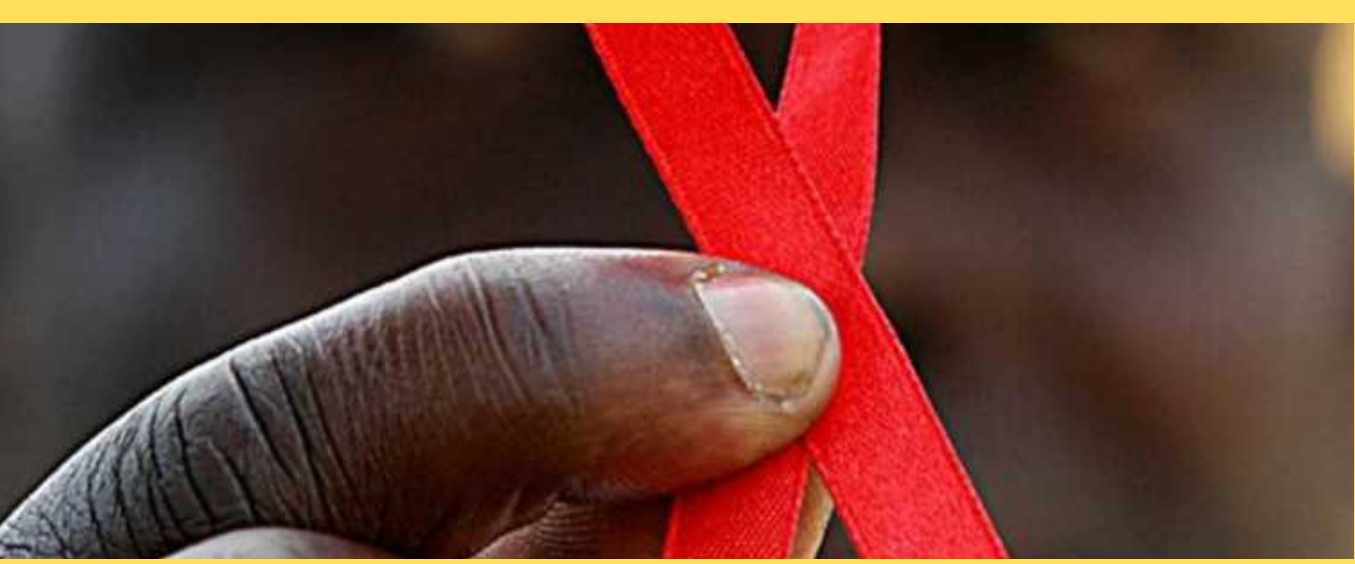
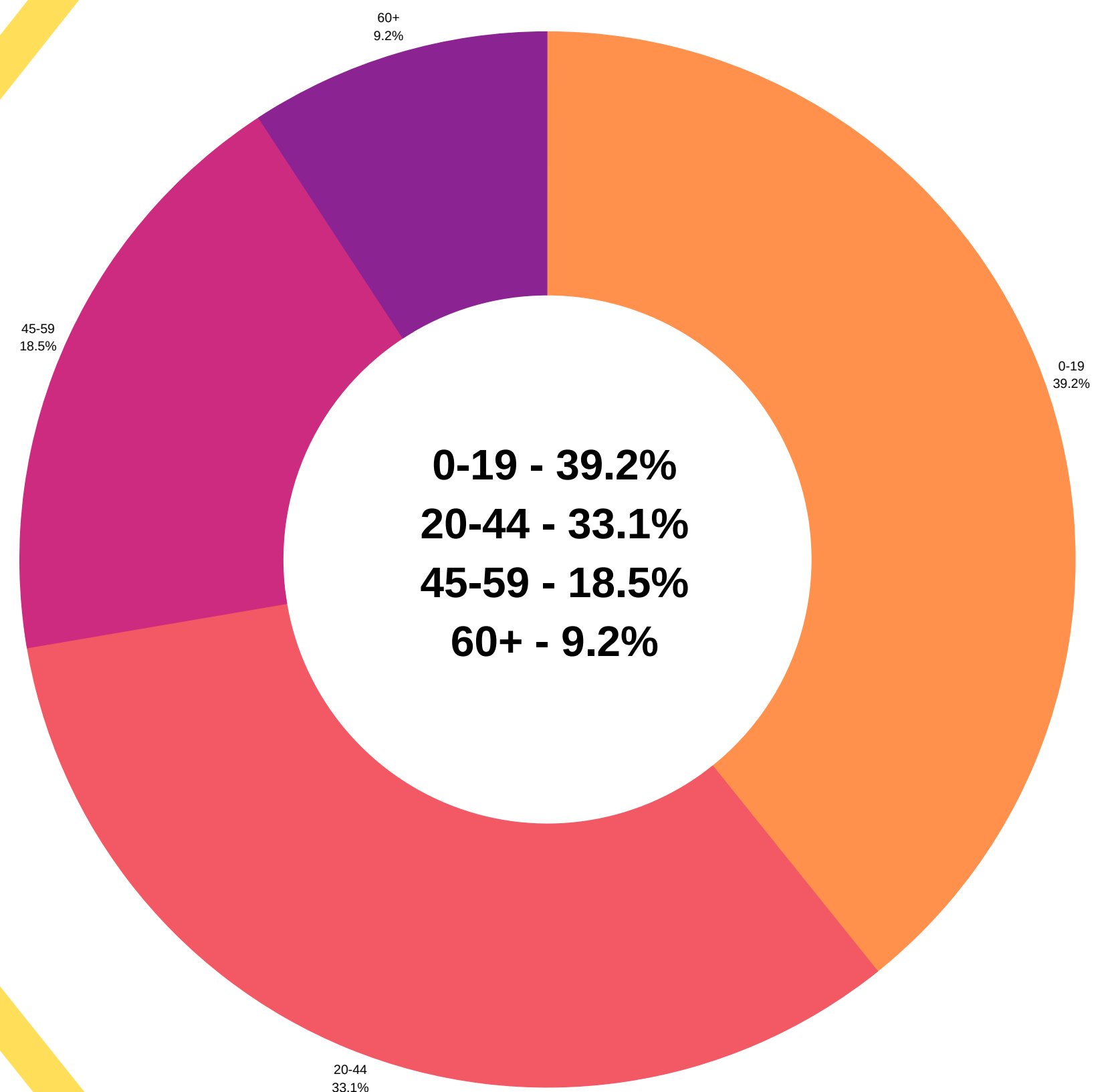
## Vision
